This week, Threod Systems, alongside nearly 30 companies in the Estonian defence industry delegation, visited Ukraine. The delegation was led by Minister of Defence Hanno Pevkur, with the visit coordinated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Estonian Embassy in Ukraine, the Ministry of Defence, and the Estonian Defence and Aerospace Industry Association.

Throughout the visit, several business seminars and workshops were held between Estonian and Ukrainian defence industry companies and Ukrainian end-users. Several Estonian companies, including Threod, had the opportunity to demonstrate their high-tech solutions to representatives from various units of the Ukrainian Armed Forces (UAF).

One of the key goals of the visit was to engage directly with Ukrainian state institutions, deepen cooperation with existing partners, and explore new connections with UAV manufacturers in Ukraine, whose platforms could be integrated with Threod's gimbals featuring laser designation.

"Precision strikes with laser-guided munitions may be one of the key capabilities where Threod and Ukrainian UAV developers could jointly drive innovation," added Pajuri.
